

# PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

**Check in** from 1130am to 7pm (later arrivals please contact Park Caretaker).  
for autumn/winter period – **check in prior to nightfall** due to safety requirements.

**Check out** by 10/1030am on day of departure.

## Security

- Obey the speed limits in the park.
- Keep belongings secured.

## Fees

- Sites are quoted at 2 adults and 2 children standard.
- Extra person additional (minimal) cost.

## Facilities

- Amenity Blocks – please consider conservation of water. Be quick and clean.
- Young children to be supervised in ablutions block.
- Laundry facilities must not be used for washing pots, pans, dishes, fish gear etc.
- Please report to the Park Caretaker any damage or uncleanliness.

## Noise

- Respect other campers – keep noise down. Noise restrictions in place from 10pm.
- After hours please report any noise disturbances to the office, call 0473-88-41-44
- Portable generators *are not* permitted to run.
- Kitchen hut is not to have amplified (doof doof music after 10pm).

## Site Condition

- Please leave your site clean. Sullage to be drained to waste point (capped) facilities provided.
- Please do not encroach onto adjacent sites. Use the site allocated to you.
- Vehicles **are not** to be driven between occupied sites.
- Rubbish. General waste and recycle bins provided. Please do not leave broken chairs/furniture at the park & we request that you break down cardboard waste 😊

## Fires

- No mesh fire pots to be used within the park.....but.....
  - enclosed fire pot raised 1 foot off of the ground can be used but **must not** spill ash. BUT – no fire post during Fire Danger Period.
- External Gas BBQs are allowed on your site. 😊
- Ensure children are watched at all times near kitchen camp fire...

## Electrical Safety

- For unpowered sites: Phones, laptops and notebooks may be charged at the kitchen area at risk to the owner (grab a book /paper and read while the appliance charges).

## Setting up your campsite

- Draw bars MUST face the roadway where your site is located. If you need help ask the Caretaker.
- By law, there needs to be a minimum of 2000mm between structure walls (vans, annexes & tents). And 1200mm unobstructed area between sites e.g. between ropes.

## General Safety

- Riding a push bike – Helmets must be on. No riding bikes after dark please.
- As a site holder it is your responsibility to ensure the safety of children and others on your site & those around you. Please ensure children supervised at all times.
- Hammocks, swings and clotheslines etc hanging from trees is not permitted.
- Drones **are not** permitted at all within the park boundaries (the main oval is an Air Ambulance landing site – drones interfere with air operations).

Dogs are welcome at Bruthen Caravan Park as long as you follow these simple rules.

- Maximum of two dogs per site regardless of size.
- Pets barking should be kept to a minimum, consider other campers.
- The dog must be always supervised and **never** left unattended at your site.
- Pets to be always restrained (including on site), leashes to be up to 3m.
- Pet waste disposal bags are the responsibility of the pet owner. Please gather up doggy doo's ☺.
- Sounds silly – but please take your pet with you when you leave,,,,,,
